**PIETER PIETERSEN OSTRANDER SR. ARRIVED IN KINGSTON IN 1663, MARRIED AT THE OLD DUTCH CHURCH IN 1679 AND MOVED TO HURLEY ABOUT 1687. STARTING 1714, MANY OF THE 12 CHILDREN OF PIETER AND REBECCA (THE FIRST AMERICAN BORN GENERATION) MOVED ACROSS THE HUDSON RIVER TO RHINEBECK. YOUR REUNION WILL VISIT AND EXPERIENCE THE SAME STREETS AND LOCATIONS WHERE YOUR PATRIARCH AND HIS DESCENDENTS LIVED. THIS IS A ONCE IN A LIFE TIME 350<sup>TH</sup> CELEBRATION.
